

# Apostille and legalization

Legalization procedure involving the passage of a document of a number of formal procedures to give it legal force on the territory of another state. Legalization of documents is carried out only on the territory of the country in which it was designed or issued. The essence of legalization is the official confirmation of the authenticity of document signatures, stamps and stamp officers to whom the document was issued. Types of legalization. ♦ Legalization is not required ♦ Apostille ♦ Consular legalization ♦ Legalization of documents at chamber of Commerce and industry of the Russian Federation International standardized form of certification of the authenticity of the documents for presentation to the countries participating in Hague Convention abolishing the requirement of legalization for foreign public documents of 5 October 1961. Apostille is a special stamp with the assigned state registration number in the international unified form. Apostille official documents shall be non-commercial in nature coming from organizations and agencies of the signatories to the Hague Convention. The first stage of the procedure of apostille is a notarized translation of documents. Then translated and notarized documents for legalization to the relevant authorities. The right Apostille on notarized copies and translations of all types of documents granted only to organs of the Ministry of justice of the Russian Federation. In accordance with the current laws, apostille documents are to be issued only by the state bodies of the Russian Federation. Therefore it is impossible to put an Apostille in Moscow for documents issued by authorities of the republics of the former USSR and diplomatic institutions of other States. As a rule Russian citizens need an Apostille of documents for submitting them in state bodies of another country. Often when going abroad you want to put the Apostille on the original documents of the state sample such as certificates and references issued by the Registrar diplomas. Mandatory for legalization are the official documents concerning the civil status sphere of education and science of judicial decision documents private entrepreneurs and legal persons as well as documents issued by notaries of the Russian Federation.
