Legalization of a document is the Commission of certain formal procedures to make the document legal force on the territory another state. The ultimate goal of legalization of the document issued on the territory of one state is the possibility of its submission to the official bodies of another state. The document legalization is almost always required when it is necessary to provide in official bodies of another state. This means that the document is issued for example, in Belarus is legal only on the territory of the Republic of Belarus where it is possible to fully use but for its representation the official authorities of another country legalization will be required. There are two types of legalization stamp of Apostille and consular legalization. The apostilization sometimes this the procedure is also called simplified legalization or the apostille is used to send the document to the country joined the Hague Convention of 5 October 1961 abolishing the requirement of consular legalization and deceptive simplified procedure of legalization - Apostille documents. A simplified such a procedure is called that because on the one hand apostilization is performed quite quickly and by only one authorized body and on the other hand, the document becomes binding on all countries acceding to the Hague of the Convention. The requirements for each type of legalization of documents of the same this procedure can be performed only on the territory of the country of registration or the issuance of the document. The exception to this rule are some types documents which cannot be legalized as well as the provision of documents in countries with which Belarus has a bilateral agreement abolishing the requirement of legalisation. Legalization of a document is always carried out only in the territory of the country in which it was issued and / or decorated. Our the Agency provides services of legalization only for documents issued or issued on the territory of the Republic of Belarus or in the territory of the BSSR in the period of its existence. Legalization of documents by Apostille stamp apply to official documents issued on the territory of one of the Contracting States and must be submitted in the territory of another of a Contracting state.
